TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. **Rules Interpretations:** The Tournament Rules Committee shall be solely responsible for the interpretation and enforcement of tournament rules. The Rules Committee will rule on any unusual situations which may occur. Their decision will be final in all instances
- 2. **Starting Position:** Starting positions will be in the order that applications are received.
- 3. **Safety and Sportsmanship:** Each Tournament participant must wear a Coast Guard Approved chest-type life preserver, properly fastened anytime his boat is underway by its main source of propulsion.
- 4. All contestants are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner at all times.
- 5. **Fish Limit and Regulations:** There will be a limit of 5 fish allowed per team/boat. N.C. Inland Fishing Regulations will apply. Legal length shall be 14", unless greater by current regulations.
- 6. **Determination of Winner:** Total weight of fish shall determine the winners. Only live fish will qualify and any dead fish shall be eliminated from weigh in. All under length fish shall be returned to the lake prior to weigh-in.
- 7. **Permitted Fishing Locations and Hours:** Fishing is permitted anywhere on Lake Norman. There will be no fishing allowed within 50 yards of another team's anchored boat. Boats will be started in flights of 25 beginning at 7:00a.m. and continuing in 15-minute intervals until all boats are underway. All teams must return to headquarters beginning at 3:00p.m. for the first flight and continuing in 15-minute intervals for each flight thereafter. Any boat returning later than its flight time shall be disqualified.
- 8. **Protests:** Any contestant wishing to protest the catch of a fellow contestant must do so in writing to the Tournament Rules Committee within thirty minutes after check-in time. The decision of the Tournament Rules Committee in such cases shall be final.
- 9. No Trolling No Live Bait One at a time.
- 10. **Ties:** In the event of ties, the tie will be broken by the largest fish between contestants. Big fish will be shared.
- 11. **Disposal of Fish:** After being weighed, all live fish will be returned to the lake.
- 12. Polygraph: Any team will be subject to a polygraph test or a stress test. Any team that fails test will be disqualified.
- 13. Entry Fees: \$100.00 per boat/team plus \$10/team for Big Fish (optional).
- 14. Fishermen must remain in boats during tournament.
- 15. No fishing in any water not accessible by boat. Example- Skimmer Wall.
